



## Vendor Application & Market Guidelines

Thank you for your interest in the Beavercreek Farmers Market. We look forward to your partnership. Please read over the Farmers Market Guidelines before filling out the form.

The Beavercreek Farmers Market is intended to provide healthy, locally grown fresh foods and horticultural products to the residents and visitors of Beavercreek. We encourage recycling, the use of earth-friendly products, small business, and increasing local commerce. The Market operates on Thursdays, 3-6pm, May 24 - September 27, 2018. There is no charge for vendors at the market.

We encourage applications from local vendors with the following products:

- \* Fresh produce
- \* Seeds, seedlings, and potted plants, flowers
- \* Processed foods (ex: cheese, chips, etc.)
- \* Baked goods
- \* Honey, maple syrup, beeswax
- \* Eggs
- \* Homemade jams, jellies, etc.

The Beavercreek Farmers Market provides a venue for the sale of organic and non-organic produce, food products, and primarily producer-grown or made goods. We are not able to accept applications from alcohol or handicraft vendors at this time.

Vendors may only sell products that they have been approved to sell. All for-sale items must be constructed, produced, or grown by vendors themselves or an associated local farmer. Commercial products will not be permitted for sale or resale at the Beavercreek Farmers Market.

All vendors must have the appropriate permits from the city of Beavercreek and/or the state of Ohio for the products being sold. Keep a copy of your permit available at all times in case of inspection.

The Beavercreek Farmers Market is located in the North parking lot of Beavercreek Nazarene Church [1850 N. Fairfield Rd., Beavercreek]. Vendors will be permitted the space of two (2) parking spots to display wares. If more space is required, approval will need to be obtained from the Administrator. All tables, tents, and display items will be provided by the vendor. Please keep your selling area clean and remove all refuse and unsold items at the end of each market day. Soliciting, political organizing, religious activities, or fundraising will not be allowed at any time at the market, by vendors or otherwise. Loud hawking is not permitted.
